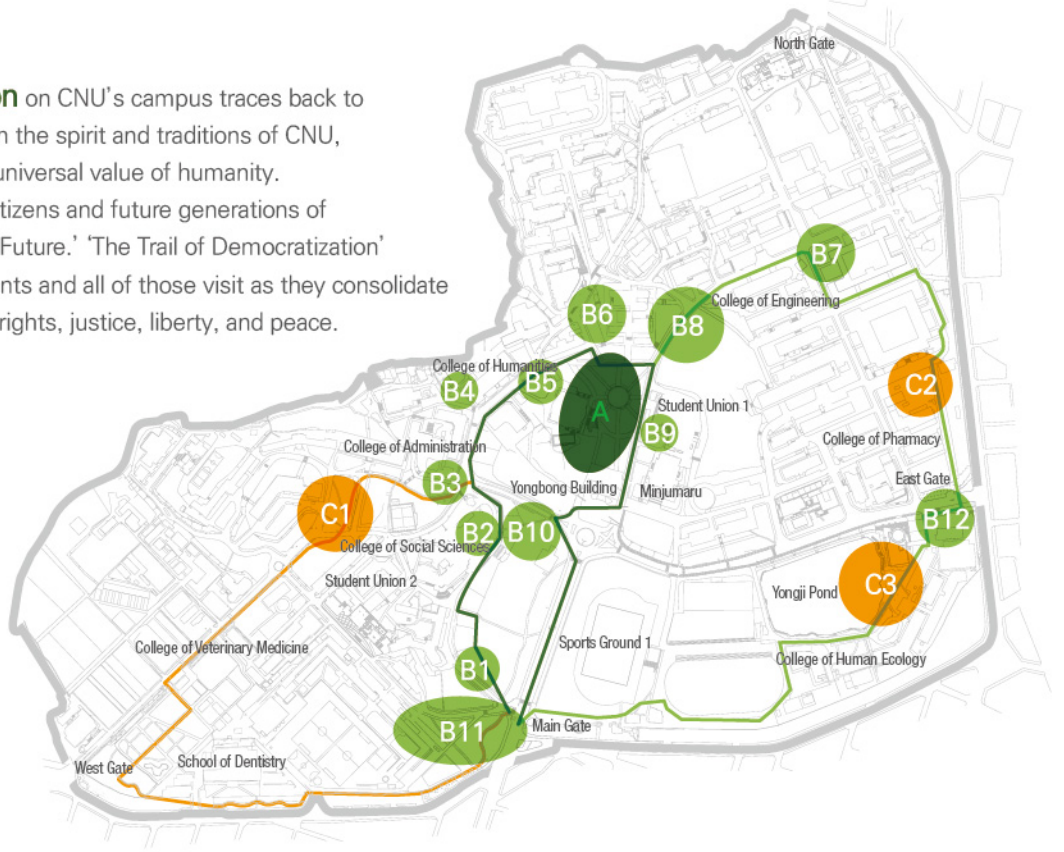

- Route 2(1.8km)** Main Gate → Minjumaru → Student Union Hall 1 → College of Engineering → College of Pharmacy → East Gate → Yongji → Main Gate
- Route 3(1.5km)** Main Gate → University Dental Hospital → College of Veterinary Medicine → Student Union Hall 2 → College of Business Administration

Being a 5km long path, 'the Trail of Democratization' connects three districts embracing 16 historic places on the CNU campus, starting from the Main Gate and its access road and to the inner cores of the campus, such as the Main Gate and entrance driveway, Youngbong roundabout, Yongbong Building, and the library. Route 1(Justice Road) emphasizes core historical locations on the CNU campus: from the Main Gate, where the May 18 Democratization Movement sparked off, the Hillside walk of Park Gwan-hyun, Forest of Yun Sang-won, Lane of Kim Nam-ju, Courtyard of 'Our Aims of Education', Mural of democracy and torchlight, Garden of Park Seung-hee, and to the monument of 'Marching for Our Beloved'. Route 2(Peace Road) running from the College of Engineering to the East Gate, connecting the College of Human Ecology, Yongji, the Sports Ground, and the Main Gate. Route 3(Road of Human Rights) encompasses the western part of the campus including the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, the School of Dentistry, the Dental Hospital, and the green tract off the campus heading back to the Main Gate.
